## **Still Empty**

Pastor Mark Wilks, ECCLESIASTES 4:4

- 1. The open door gives us hope.
  - There is no win in comparison.
  - Discontentment fueled by <u>comparison</u> is dangerous because it often drives us to be discontent with God. Romans 8:28
  - What if you missed <u>God's purpose</u> in your life because you were <u>chasing</u> the <u>wrong dream</u>?

"And I saw that **all toil** and **all achievement** spring from <u>one person's envy of another</u>. This too is meaningless, <u>a chasing after the wind</u>." Ecclesiastes 4:4

- 2. The open door gives us security. Genesis 22:1-14
  - God wants us to find our <u>security in Him</u> not <u>the gift</u>.
  - Security brings confidence in God. Hebrews 11:11
  - Confidence took him out the door but obedience brought the encounter with God.
- 3. The open door leads us to significance.
  - Sometimes God makes <u>us wait to see what He is doing</u>.

- Are you seeking God's <u>purposes</u> or your <u>desires</u>?
- How <u>long are you</u> willing to <u>wait on God</u>?
