#### **Introduction:**

• Studying the Bible leads to prayer & worship and now conviction to covenant. Neh. 10:3

# 1. Honoring the Lord in a public covenant.

- The 84 names listed are to show the unity in the community.
- The people have read the bible and are following the <u>example the teaching</u>. Deut. 29:9–12
- The Bible is alive, it brings <u>conviction to our heart</u> the question is, "How will you <u>respond?</u>" Hebrews 4:12-13

**Application:** What <u>public</u> covenants have I made that I need to <u>elevate in my life</u>?

## 2. Honoring the Lord in our relationships.

- It may have been that many of those who returned from exile were <u>men</u> and they had difficulty finding a Jewish bride.
- They had the challenge of <u>settling for less than God's ideal</u> because of the circumstances.
- The biblical teaching on being "equally yoked" is not racial or cultural, it's spiritual. 2 Cor. 6:14

**Application:** This week spend some time remembering ways <u>God has worked in your life</u>.

## 3. Honoring the Lord with our time.

• They will not permit the greed or lust of others to cause them to stumble in following God.

**Application:** Are there ways you are allowing <u>others to hinder</u> your <u>walk with the Lord</u>?

### 4. Honoring the Lord with our blessings.

• <u>Submission</u> to the authority of God's Word is the <u>unmistakable</u> understanding here.

**Application:** Is there something you are <u>holding back from God</u>?
