## Our 4 default questions: Jesus answers them, again!

- 1) Why?
- 2) Who are you?
- 3) Where do you get your authority?
- 4) What's in it for me?
- 1. Jesus declares, "I have something you need."
  - The Samaritan woman failed to grasp who Jesus is.
  - What if, by thirst, Jesus means emptiness?
  - Jesus compels this woman to see her greatest sin, which has resulted in her <u>hopelessness</u>, <u>guilt</u>, and <u>despair</u>.
- 2. Jesus declares, "I am the Messiah."
  - She acknowledges his <u>wisdom</u> comes from God.
  - Salvation is through the Jews: including the Father, His prophecy, and the Jewish Messiah.
  - Worship is to come from the depth of our <u>souls</u> in response to the <u>truth</u> of God.
- 3. Jesus declares, "I am welcoming of all."
  - In her eagerness to share the new and living water, she <u>abandons</u> the old <u>water jar</u>.
  - She now goes to the people she had <u>avoided</u>.

• This worship can take place only in and through him because he is the true <u>temple</u>.
